

In our previous November consultation, we set out the following opportunities and vision that we had for Montgomery's Wharf.

REGENERATING BRENTFORD OUTSIDE THE TOWN CENTRE

Brentford town centre has received considerable investment and development. The redevelopment of this Site offers a different opportunity to invest and unlock Brentford outside of its centre, enhance the local ecology, introduce greater activation of the riverside and celebrate the historic wharf. Our vision is to create a new urban quarter that is safe, accessible and offers a beautiful public realm.

Further investment in this area will provide a necessary boost to local shops and businesses who may be struggling as a result of the pandemic.

NEW EMPLOYMENT SPACE

Whilst predominantly providing new homes, the scheme will also deliver other uses. We are currently examining what is needed within the community and discussions with the Council are ongoing. These alternative uses will create new jobs for local people and contribute to Brentford's local economy.

NEW PEDESTRIAN LINKS

New pedestrian links will be introduced to create better connectivity to the community and breathe life into the Wharf. The plans will see new pathways through the Site from east to west and from Brentford High Street to the riverfront. Urban greening will boost the experience for people offering access to a vibrant waterfront that connects to the wider Thames Path. The use of materials associated with the historic timber yard will connect the scheme and experience to the Wharf's rich industrial heritage.
